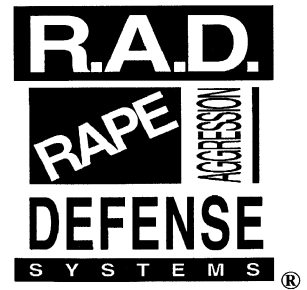

Biola University's Campus Safety will be hosting a R.A.D. 30-hour Basic Physical Defense instructor certification course in May 2022. R.A.D. is the strongest self-defense network in the country. The course meets or exceeds all guidelines for choosing a self-defense program prepared by the National Coalition against Sexual Assault (NCASA). Programs are taught at over 450 university police departments, municipal police and sheriff departments, local transit companies, military bases, and independents across the U.S. and Canada. At this time there are nearly 10,000 instructors certified internationally. The course will be taught by an authorized RAD Instructor Trainers.

Cost: \$450. Registration includes a 200+ page Instructor's curriculum with participant manual to copy, and Instructor's certificate. A 10% discount (\$405 each) is available to agencies that register 3 or more participants. However, all must attend.
